



AGREEMENT OF INTERNATIONAL DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM
BETWEEN JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY, KOREA
AND YANGZHOU UNIVERSITY, CHINA

Jeonbuk National University (JBNU) and Yangzhou University (YZU) hereby conclude this Agreement to execute International Dual Degree Program (IDDP) for postgraduate students between the two universities.

Upon this agreement, students who complete the IDDP shall obtain a master's or doctoral degree in one major from each university, under the following conditions.

1. Admissions: IDDP students are selected initially by the home university, and the final decisions of admission to the host university are made by the host university. Applications to the host university must meet the deadlines designated by the host university.
2. Payment of tuition fee: IDDP students are required to pay tuition fees to the home and/or host universities. During their study period at the host university, payment of tuition fee to the host university is mandatory, while payment to the home university shall be determined by their home university.
3. Staying period at the host university: IDDP students for master's and doctoral degree programs shall stay at the host university at least one and two years, respectively.
4. Obtaining degree: IDDP students who complete the degree requirement of each university shall obtain a master's or doctoral degree from each university. More detailed degree requirements may be further decided according to the separate discussions.
5. Other expenses than tuition fee: IDDP students or their sponsors are responsible for travel living, and other necessary expenses incurred by the students. This does not preclude the application of scholarships from independent institutions to such expenses.
6. Academic advisor: For IDDP students, the host university may appoint a qualified academic advisor.
7. Scope of majors: IDDP major covers Division of Electronic and Information Engineering in JBNU and Computer Science and Technology, Software Engineering, Control Science and Engineering, Electronical Technology and Communication in College of Information Engineering (College of Artificial Intelligence) in Yangzhou University. IDDP majors may be added upon mutual agreement by the two universities.
8. Courses and credits: Each university agrees to provide the other with information of the Major and Elective courses. The credits earned at the home university by IDDP students can be transferred to the host university.
9. Academic records: Each university agrees to provide the other with students' transcript and the other academic records.
10. Others: Other matters will be decided according to the separate discussion in each case. If there is no discussion, individual issues will follow the previous case.



11. Effective period: This Agreement is effective for a period of five years from the signed date, and may be automatically renewed for every five years period at the expiration unless one university gives the other a six-month prior notice in writing.
12. Additional term : At the termination of this Agreement, both universities should ensure those students who have already been admitted into this program can continue to study until their completion of this program in accordance with the terms of this Agreement or other conditions and terms agreed upon by both universities through negotiation.
13. Intellectual property: In principle, intellectual property rights of academic achievements obtained under the supervision of two advisors from JBNU and YZU shall be shared by both parties. The specific requirements shall comply with the official rules in JBNU and YZU.
